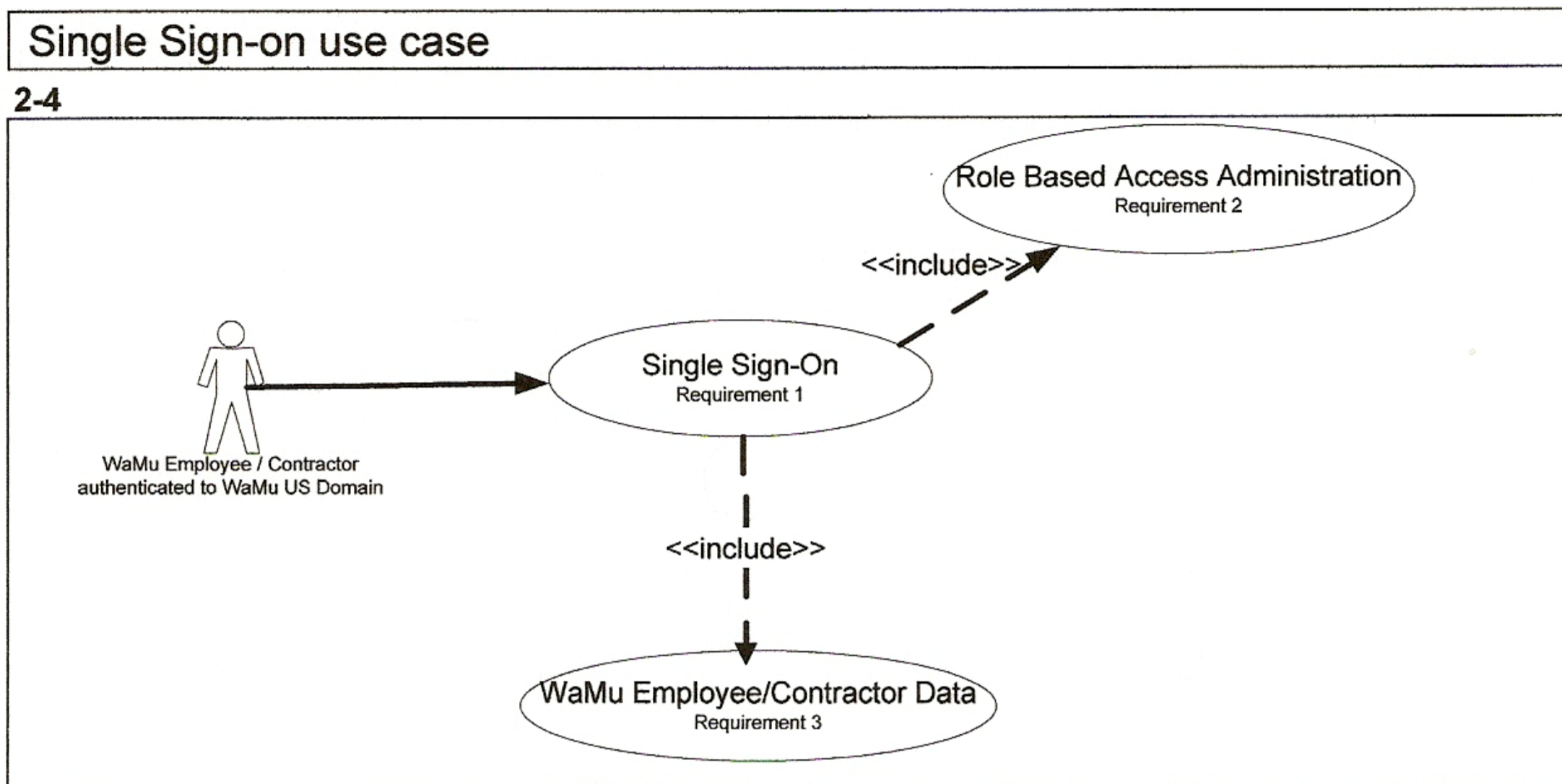


2.2.3 Single Sign On Use cases

Use cases which are provided by the business are ideal when developing and confirming functionality. In some cases assistance from technology maybe required to deliver the level of detail required. The use case below is from project #23035:



The flow detailed below describes the interaction between a CVM user, WaMu infrastructure and the initial sign on events which occur during authentication to the CVM hosted solution:

Frequency: Single sign-on activity is expected to occur as often as several times a minute throughout the business day.

Actors: All WaMu employees and Contractors who have authenticated to the WaMu US domain

Priority: High

Performance: The authentication event should occur immediately – to the user it should appear nearly instantaneous.

Basic Flow – Authentication from the WaMu.net link

Pre-Conditions/Assumptions

1. The user has authenticated to the WaMu US domain
2. The CVM solution is available for user authentication
3. .

Main Steps

1. The user navigates to the CVM application link on the launch page (controlled by Enterprise Spend Management) within wamu.net and activates the link via mouse click or key stroke.
2. The system response is to initiate authentication via SSO to the CVM application
